


## HALF SEASON OVERVIEW

# PRACTICES & ATTENDANCE

Half Season teams will practice one day a week for two hours. Due to the shorter season, ALL PRACTICES ARE MANDATORY. During certain times of the Half Season, an extra practice may be called. Your coach will try to give at least a one week notice regarding any extra practices. All team members are expected to attend all extra practices. During the parent meetings please bring any conflicts you may have between November through the end April.

#### **EVALUATION PROCESS / TEAM PLACEMENTS**

Teams will be determined by the athletes attending this year's Half Season tryout. Team levels will be determined by our Woodlands Elite coaching staff after the first month of practices to ensure all athletes and teams are set up for overall success! We will hold an official team reveal for all half season athletes at your location on Saturday, 10/25/25 from 12:00-1:00pm!



PARENT MEETINGS / TEAM CHOREOGRAPHY
Teams will have a **parent meeting** with their coaches on the **first night of team practice**. Meeting times will be released with your athlete's team placement information. We will be sizing athletes for practice wear, cheer shoes & uniform within the first 2 weeks of practice in November. Please plan to attend! We will have scheduled choreography dates in January 2026. All families are expected to keep these dates open once they are provided. Families will be notified of choreography times during your parent meeting.

## HALF-SEASON TRYOUT

All locations will hold half-season tryouts on **Saturday**, **October 18th**, **from 12:00-2:00pm for Tiny/Mini aged athletes** (**birth years 2016-2021**) and **2:00-4:00pm for Youth/Junior/Senior aged athletes** (**birth years 6/1/2006-2015**). Athletes will need to wear comfortable clothes, tennis/cheer shoes & hair pulled back to try-out. Can't make it to try-outs? Please contact your desired location to schedule an individual try-out time!

### **Important Information**

- •If you have any questions or concerns that need immediate attention, please use the following chain of communication. 1) Team Coach 2) All-Star Director 3) Owner/President
- •NO outside merchandise of any kind may be designed, purchased, or distributed. This includes but is not limited to any items containing references to Woodlands Elite (name or logo) or any Woodlands Elite team name. This includes team slogans, abbreviated team names i.e Blops, Smoke, Addy's, Lops, Gens, etc. Merchandise made with any references to a team of any kind will be cause for dismissal from the program. This does not include snacks, cakes, cookies, or consumable goodie bag items.
- •Solicitation of any items while on Woodlands Elite property is prohibited.
- •All practices and competitions are mandatory. Any extra practice that is scheduled at least one week in advance must be attended by all team members.
- •Woodlands Elite reserves the right to close any practice for outside viewing at any time.
- •You must arrive at practices and competitions on time.
- Athletes are required to wear the appropriate practice wear to every practice.
- Anyone threatening to quit or pull their child from a team may be dismissed from the program immediately.
- •You are making an 6-month commitment. You are required to honor this commitment.
- •It is the parent's responsibility to know what is going on with your team. Check your emails and team group communications regularly.
- •The Woodlands Elite parent viewing area is expected to be a positive environment for parents to enjoy watching their kids. If you cannot maintain a positive attitude in the parent viewing area you may be prohibited from utilizing the area and designated as a "drop off only" parent. Please do not be that parent.
- •Social media posts that are a poor representation of Woodlands Elite may result in removal from the program.
- •Parents, relatives, athletes, and friends will not contact competition officials for ANY reason. All questions or comments relating to event producers or their officials should be directed to Woodlands Elite Directors or Owners.
- •Parents and family members are required to conduct themselves with professionalism and dignity at all times. Any actions/altercations deemed a poor representation of Woodlands Elite may be cause for the family to be immediately removed from the program.
- •If your athlete quits or is removed from the program you will not receive a refund of any kind.
